**NOTICE OF HEARING**

**To: Black Sand Equity Management Ltd. (the Respondent)**

**NOTICE:**

An application is being made to the Alberta Securities Commission (**Commission**) by Staff Counsel (**Staff**), for an Order pursuant to section 198(1.1) of the Act, that:

- (i) Under section 198(1)(a) of the Act, that trading in the securities of Black Sand Equity Management Ltd. cease until the Executive Director of the British Columbia Securities Commission (“BCSC”) revokes the cease trade order dated December 30, 2009.

**GROUND FOR APPLICATION:**

In support of the application, Staff will rely on grounds that the Respondent is subject to orders made by the BCSC, as securities regulatory authority in Canada, which imposed conditions, restrictions or requirements on the Respondent.

**EVIDENCE IN SUPPORT OF APPLICATION:**

In support of this application, Staff will rely upon the Affidavit of Tyler Hynes, Assistant Securities Investigator, which accompanies this application and the exhibits referred to in that Affidavit.

**PROCEDURE:**

The Respondent has an opportunity to be heard in this application, and may do so with or without legal counsel.

If the Respondent wishes to make oral submissions or present evidence (or both) to the Commission, they must within 21 days of the date of this Notice contact Jayne Lewis, Registrar, by telephone at 403.297.4277, email at [Jayne.Lewis@asc.ca](mailto:Jayne.Lewis@asc.ca), or facsimile at 403.297.4486, following which a hearing date and time will be set.

If the Respondent wishes to make written submissions, they must within 28 days of the date of this Notice deliver the submissions, together with any supporting materials, to Jayne Lewis, c/o Alberta Securities Commission, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor, 300 - 5 Avenue SW, Calgary, Alberta, T2P 3C4.

The Respondent may choose to make both oral and written submissions, with or without evidence, in which case they must comply with each of the above time limits.

The Commission will consider the application on or after 30 days from the date of this Notice and may make an order against the Respondents without further notice if they fail to respond as directed above.
