Background

1. Miles Technology Inc. (the **Issuer**) is a reporting issuer under the *Securities Act* (Alberta) (the **Act**) and has failed to file the following periodic disclosure pursuant to section 146 of the Act:
 - (a) annual audited financial statements, annual management's discussion and analysis and certification of the annual filings for the year ended 30 September 2018.

Interpretation

2. Terms defined in the Act have the same meaning if used in this order, unless otherwise defined.

Order

3. Under section 33.1 of the Act, it is ordered that trading or purchasing cease in respect of each security of the Issuer until this order has been revoked or varied.
4. Despite this order a beneficial securityholder of the Issuer who is not, and was not at the date of this order, an insider or control person of the Issuer, may sell securities of the Issuer acquired before the date of this order if both of the following apply:
 - (a) the sale is made through a "foreign organized regulated market", as defined in section 1.1 of the Universal Market Integrity Rules of the Investment Industry Regulatory Organization of Canada; and
 - (b) the sale is made through an investment dealer registered in a jurisdiction of Canada in accordance with applicable securities legislation.
